"An Education" was the winner of the Audience Award at the 2009 Sundance Film Festival.

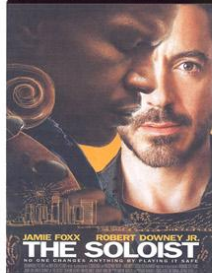

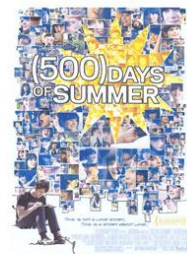


THE SEPTEMBER ISSUE
